Technical Requirements

Show for all audiences, for theatre and street.

Length: 55 minutes

Stage: 6,5 meters high, 8 meters wide, 7 meters long

Rigging: 4 rigging points of 500 Kg, forming a square of 10 m.

(Ideal but adaptable. See the document attached)

Get in: 7 hours

Get out 1,5 hours

Lighting: A minimum of 12 channels.

Sound: Sound system with enough power to cover the audience space and connect to a Mac book pro.

Dressing room.

Safe parking for our trailer.

Access with our van and trailer to the place of the performance.



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
